Costs provided are in Canadian dollars and the fees quoted are subject to change at the discretion of the respective agencies.

Licensing with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) *

\$431.25 Application Fee (non-refundable), plus \$345.00 Membership Fee

Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) *

\$229.00/month

Criminal Record Check *

\$45.00 - Trainees arrange their own Criminal Record Check after arrival in Canada through the Hamilton Police Services Office.

Work Authorization Permit (required by CPSO for licensing)

\$150.00 per worker; additional costs for family members

Health Insurance Coverage **

University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) and Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP)

UHIP costs are paid for by the individual for 3 months before being eligible for OHIP. OHIP will be covered for the trainee after the 3 month period. Family members are not covered unless the individual is in the training program for a minimum of three years.

\$53.00/month (one person) \$106.00/month (one person plus one dependent) \$159.00/month (one person plus 2 or more dependents)

Housing Costs in Hamilton

Approximate monthly rental fees are dependent upon the accommodation size (number of bedrooms) and location. Rates range from \$700/month to \$1500+/month.
