COVID-19 UPDATES

The PGME office is closely watching the current surge in numbers of COVID-19 cases. Up to this point, redeployment has not been necessary but may still occur in the coming weeks/months. We will

continue to keep everyone up to date as information becomes available.

Travel & Isolation - Currently, as per our hospital guidelines, all PG Learners are required to self- isolate when returning from international travel, including those coming to McMaster for electives. Self-isolation does not extend to domestic travel (i.e. those travelling within Canada) at this time.
